Students arriving after 7:30am will be considered late for school.

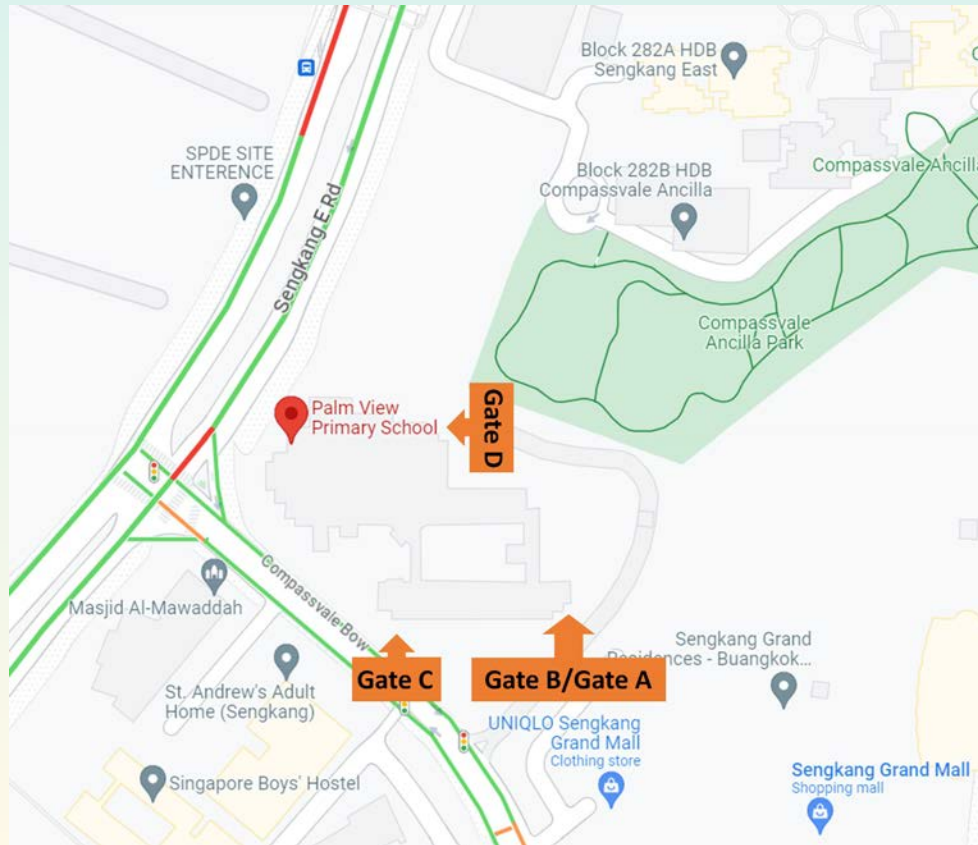

Food sold in the Canteen



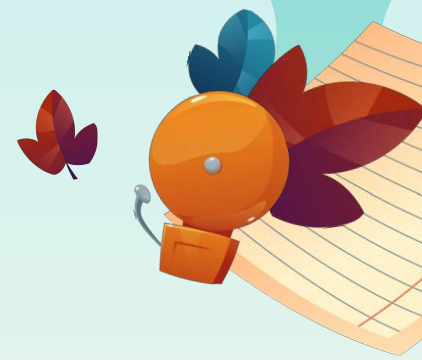

# 07 Frequently Asked Questions



## Question 1

What should my child pack in his/her school bag everyday?

- Pencil case and coloured pencils
- Student diary
- English storybook (Mondays to Wednesdays)
- Mother Tongue storybook (Thursdays and Fridays)
- Water bottle
- Pocket money/lunch box
- Snack for the 10-minute snack break
- 1 A4 homework file (for your child to keep any worksheets or Palm View(PV) Connection from school)

## Question 2

How much pocket money should be given to my child every day?

- Suggested amount: \$2.50 - \$3.00
- Each meal is \$2.00 (excluding drinks).



# 07 Frequently Asked Questions



## Question 3

What will happen on the first week of school?

- Students will go through a 3-day Back-to-School Programme with their teachers for a smooth transition into primary school.
- The Primary One Buddy Programme in which a middle primary student would be paired up with a P1 student would run during these three days.

## Question 4

Do parents get to accompany their child on the first week of school?

- Parents will be allowed to accompany their child only on the first day of school, Friday (2 January 2026).
- More details will be sent at a later date.

## Question 5

How does the school keep the parents informed of school activities?

- Parents are to download the app, “Parents Gateway (PG)” as important information will be sent via it.
- Look out for the monthly Palm View (PV) Connection to be kept informed of the school activities/events/ closure for the month.
